Report 2024 Name of Community Council: Llangelynnin

Llangelynnin Community Council has a population of 562 on its Electoral Register (01.12.16) with community wards covering Rhoslefain and Llwyngwriil.

It is approximately 10km x 2km area and Precept for Llangelynnin Community Council was £13,369 for 2024-25.

Llangelynnin Community Council is responsible for maintaining the Play Park and the War Memorial in Llwyngwriil.

Action Report

Action carried out to embed biodiversity into decision making and procurement:

Action carried out to tackle negative factors: reduce pollution, address invasive species:

- Control Japanese Knotweed on land in council control
- Report infestations.

Action carried out to support other organisations:

- Support community initiative to eradicate Japanese Knotweed

Review of Section 6 duty

Progress has been in the last years to tackle the Japanese Knotweed problem.

All contractors will be informed upon being awarded a contract that they need to be aware of and actively check for wildlife habitats during the nesting season.

The Section 6 duty will be monitored by the Community Council at their monthly meetings and the Section 6 plan will be reviewed annually.
