Minutes of the Community Council Meeting held on 13.07.16 – 7.00pm at "Y Ganolfan"

- 1. <u>Chairperson's Welcome</u>: A warm welcome was extended to all to the meeting.
- 2. <u>Apologies Received</u>: Karen Shellis.
- **3.** <u>Approval of previous minutes (08.06.16)</u>: Previous meeting's minutes were agreed a true account and approved. **Proposed** – Huw Davies **Second** – Kevin Goodchild **Signed** – Geraint Edwards.

<u>Matters arising from the previous meeting (08.06.16)</u>: <u>Community Matters</u> – reply received from Gwynedd Council responding to last meeting's enquiries:

- a) Rubbish and Recycling Bins in Rhoslefain Gwynedd Council is aware that the bins are being misused by some of the area's residents and visitors over the summer months, and in order to cope with this, Gwynedd Council have arranged additional collections. As there isn't enough space for more blue recycling bins on site, a Recycling Frame has been put up there recently and these recycling boxes will be collected weekly.
- **b)** Hedge in Rhoslefain This site has been inspected by Gwynedd Council who agree that the hedge needs to be cut back as much as possible. The Supervisor has instructed his workforce of the work to be undertaken.
- c) Hedge at Old School Site in Llwyngwril Gwynedd Council is aware of the problem of overgrowth here and has transferred the compliant to the Property Department of Gwynedd Council.
- d) Field at Old School Site in Llwyngwril Gwynedd Council have received the request for a local farmer to cut and bale the grass at this site. The request has been sent on to the Property Department, to respond directly.

5. Correspondence:

- a) Shelter Cymru: request received for a financial contribution \rightarrow decision was made not to support this request.
- b) Dail Dysynni: request for a financial contribution **Resolution** \rightarrow all agree to support this request = **f50.00**.

- c) AON Insurance: letter received confirming the policy has been renewed 01.06.2016.
- d) Playsafe Ltd: Safety Inspection Report of the Play Park in Llwyngwril received. Satisfactory report on the whole. Rust on some of the equipment and a bolt missing on one of the equipment.
 Resolution → Huw Davies and Geraint Edwards offered to inspect this piece of equipment.
- e) Gwynedd Council
 - I. Letter received confirming that an Officer will contact Mr Pugh, Henblas to discuss the situation regarding water running from the main road, towards his property.
 - **II.** Street Enforcement Investigation form completed ready to be sent to Gwynedd Council.
 - III. Salt Bins letter received confirming the fee for GC continuing to service the salt bins = \pm 80/bin. Resolution \rightarrow reply to Gwynedd Council confirming that the Community Council accept this offer.

IV. Public Toilets in the Community – in an attempt to avoid toilet closures, Gwynedd Council need to establish whether the Community Council would be willing to contribute financially and enter into a partnership with Gwynedd Council to maintain the current public toilet provision for 2017-18. Then other opportunities could be considered by either extending the partnership arrangement for the following year or, develop arrangements to transfer responsibility for the public toilet provision in the community to the Community Council.

The annual financial contribution from Llangelynnin Community Council to enter into a partnership with Gwynedd Council to maintain current public toilet provision for 2017-18 will be £2,000.00 a term (Llwyngwril toilets are only open for 6 months of the year).

Form to be completed and returned by 01.08.16.

Resolution \rightarrow complete the form expressing an interest in the partnership, but that the sum of £2,000 is too high to pay for this service for only 6 months of the year, and that the Community Council need more time to discuss this matter.
