2. <u>Chairperson's Welcome</u>: A warm welcome was extended to all to the meeting, when new roles for 2020/21 were discussed.

- 4. Matters arising from the previous meeting (10.09.20):
 - a) Signs for Public Footpath in Llwyngwril: Reply received from Public Footpaths Officer,
 Gwynedd Council, confirming that signs are available to place on public footpaths to remind users
 of the Covid-19 guidelines → to keep a safe distance +++

As there are a number of environmental issues in this coastal area any remedial work will need to be consulted and approved by Natural Resources Wales.
- c) Footpath to the beach at Sunbeach Caravan Site, Llwyngwril: Reply received from Gwynedd Council confirming that they are in the process of investigating this matter and will be updating the Community Council as soon as they have more information available.
